Application for the Additional Areas of Simplified Temporary Land Allocation (STLA) - TP 1463

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) PWP Item No. 6720TH

Widening of Tolo Highway/Fanling Highway between Island House Interchange and Fanling – Stage 2 ("the Project")

Contract No. HY/2012/06 Widening of Fanling Highway – Tai Hang to Wo Hop Shek Interchange

Locations: 1)

- 1) The area from Tong Hang Tung to Kiu Tau Road, Tai Po
- 2) The area near Yuen Leng, Tai Po
- 3) The area near Nam Wa Po, Tai Po

Approval is hereby given for the temporary allocation to you of the areas of Government land at (i) the area from Tong Hang Tung to Kiu Tau Road, (ii) the area near Yuen Leng, and (iii) the area near Nam Wa Po (excluding any public road or street and any land allocated to other departments) as shown coloured blue on the attached plans (Annex I and Annex II respectively) for the captioned project, subject to the following engineering conditions: -

- (i) The sites are allocated to you for the period from 28 November 2013 to 31 December 2019 only.
- (ii) The areas as shown coloured blue on the attached plans shall not be used for any purpose other than the works sites and works areas in connection with the captioned project.
- (iii) Excavation within the sites in connection with the aforesaid purposes is permitted.
- (iv) No site formation or general disturbance of existing site conditions shall be undertaken without the prior consent in writing of the appropriate authority. Site investigations may be undertaken without such written approval.
- (v) No drain or nullah, water pipe, sewer, cable or any other existing site works or installations whatsoever on the sites shall be interfered with without the written consent of the appropriate authority who shall impose such conditions regarding removal, diversion or reinstatement elsewhere as may be required and paid for as part of the project.

- (vi) Damage or obstruction caused to any nullah, drain, water main, cable or other installation within or adjoining the sites shall be made good at the cost of the project and to the satisfaction of the appropriate authority.
- (vii) Any damage done to adjoining public roads shall be made good to the satisfaction of the appropriate authority and paid for as part of the project.
- (viii) All storm or rain water from the sites including any access road thereto shall be conveyed to the sea or the nearest stream course, catchpit, channel or storm water drain. All temporary and permanent works shall be paid for from the project vote and carried out in such a manner that no damage or nuisance is caused by storm water or rain water to adjacent property and any claims arising out of damage or nuisance caused by storm water or rain water shall be paid for at the cost of the project.
- (ix) Application should be made direct to the appropriate authority should any water supply or drainage connection be required, and if a connection can be made, it shall be paid for as part of the project.
- (x) No right of ingress or egress to or from the sites for the passage of motor vehicles will be permitted except with the consent of AC for T/NT, TD and subject to any conditions he may impose.
- (xi) No structure shall be erected on the sites other than those as may be required to facilitate the use and enjoyment of the areas for the approved user and authorized by the District Lands Officer.
- (xii) Immediately upon handing over the sites, adequate fencing or other works shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the District Lands Officer and at the cost of the project to prevent illegal occupation of or dumping on the sites.
- (xiii) No trees growing on the sites shall be interfered with or removed without the prior written consent of the District Lands Officer who may in granting consent impose such conditions as to replanting as he may deem appropriate. All necessary steps shall be taken to protect the general environment, landscape and plants within and adjoining the sites.
- (xiv) Portions of the works sites may be allocated to other government departments for works, you may wish to liaise with relevant allocatees for interfacing issues.
- (xv) All reasonable measures shall be taken to prevent deterioration of the general environment by the suppression of noise, dust, smells and the discharge of any effluent, rubbish, debris etc. whatsoever from the sites.
- (xvi) On completion of construction or at the expiry or cancellation or sooner determination of the allocation, the sites or any part thereof shall be handed back free of structures and debris and cleared of all occupation in a condition to the satisfaction of the District Lands Officer who may require the sites to be reinstated and fenced to his satisfaction at the cost of the project.

- 2. This allocation is made without prior circulation to other Government departments and is subject to your satisfying the requirements of any other necessary departments. If any other department raises an objection to the proposed allocation, the allocation may be suspended pending consideration of such objection or query and may be withdrawn if any objection is upheld or may be amended as appropriate.
- 3. You should be aware that the allocated areas affect the following land status and it is necessary for you to approach the relevant parties shown below for consent before commencement of your works:
